



WHAT ARE THE TPP AND RCEP?

	Trans-Pacific Partnership	Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership
Countries	Chile, New Zealand and Singapore, Brunei, US, Australia, Vietnam, Peru, Malaysia, Mexico, Canada, Japan.	10 ASEAN states and Australia, China, India, Japan, Korea and New Zealand.
	Announced interest in the end of 2013: Taiwan and South Korea	
Timing	(TPP) began in 2005 as the Pacific-4 (a FTA between Chile, New Zealand and Singapore, Brunei), US joined in 2008.	The negotiations were formally launched in November 2012 at the ASEAN Summit in Cambodia.
	Trade liberalisation in goods, services,	
Areas of cooperation	investment, intellectual property rights, environmental protection, labour, financial services, technical barriers to trade and other regulatory issue (WTO+ issues).	Trade liberalisation in goods, services and investment, technical cooperation, intellectual property dispute settlement (WTO+ issues).

ASEAN's leading role in promoting RCEP


China's situation

AUSTRALIA support tpp





- 3. LACK OF CLOSE STRATEGIC RAPPROCHEMENT BETWEEN COUNTRIES (USA-CHINA)
- 4. DIFFERENT GOALS IN THE FURTHER EVOLUTION OF THIS TWO PLATFORMS
