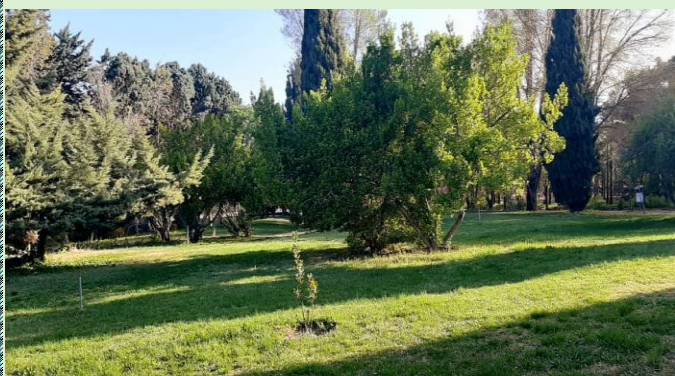

The immense and glorious beauty of Isfahan made the French symbolist poet, Henri de Régnier, to simply echo the famous Persian proverb “Isfahan is half of the world”.

The city has so far signed sisterhood agreements with 17 big cities from all around the globe; among the most famous are Freiburg, Barcelona, Florence, St. Petersburg, Baalbek, Shiyan, and Kyoto. In 2006, Isfahan was elected as the capital of the Islamic Culture by the Islamic Conference of Culture Ministers. However, Isfahan has always practiced cultural and religious diversity. For nearly four centuries, the Jolfa neighborhood in Isfahan hosts originally Armenian compatriots who follow the Christian faith. Zoroastrians and Jews have also lived in the city since ancient times.

Testing

Testing in general, and language testing in particular, is a challenging field; however, we are more than ready to get challenged and to unlock our potential. Testing is a critical part of every language teaching and language learning experience. It will encourage the learners and will motivate them in learning the language. It will also help the learners prepare themselves and consequently learn the materials. At the International Center of teaching Persian to Non-Persian Speakers (ICTP), we set great store by language testing. Therefore, language tests are properly designed, constructed and administered by our team of highly skillful test makers. Some of the various standard language tests are placement Tests and Achievement tests.

The first step in your learning process would be to precisely identify the level at which you should begin your study. We use placement tests to determine the most appropriate channel of education for you. The Persian Placement Test has four sections: reading, writing, listening, and speaking.

It is important to say that due to the continued COVID19 pandemic, you can try our online Persian placement test. After you have submitted your answers, you will be given an estimation of your current level of Persian. Thereby, we can place you on the right courses.



Certificates

Summer School 2024

University of Isfahan holds Persian Summer School for all Persian language enthusiasts at any levels in Summer 2024.

This Summer school will be held an 80-hours Persian Courses from Saturday to Wednesday (8:00 A.m. – 12:00 A.m.) in University of Isfahan for four weeks.

This one-month school will be held in 3 periods:

- 1- July 1st 2024 - July 25th 2024
- 2- July 31st 2024 - August 25th 2024
- 3- August 31st 2024 - September 25th 2024

To participate in this school, Persian learners can choose one or all mentioned periods according to their condition.

According to schedule of Persian Learning center, when all Persian Learners and students of this summer school finish their classes each session, they can visit tourist attractions of Isfahan every afternoon, along with strengthening their language skills in a real environment, they can get to know Iran.

Registration time:

Registration will be open on March 15th 2024 and the placement test will be taken from the registered language learners and according to their results they will be put in the right level.

Payment terms:

Tuition: Participation in this summer school will be 300 dollars (for each term.)

Students should pay in person at the Persian learning center in University of Isfahan.

Students who have participated in the previous Persian courses in University of Isfahan will get 10% discount.

Students who participate in this school in group (groups of 5 or more) will get 20% discount.

Students who participate in 2 or 3 mentioned periods will get 30% discount.

Teacher Training Courses

Following a unified and goal oriented education system, the International Center of Teaching Persian to Non-Persian Speakers (ICTP) is offering Teacher Training Course for native Persian speakers who wish to pursue a career, teaching Persian to non-Persian speakers in Iran or other countries. Those who attend the sessions and present their Demo, will receive a Certificate of Course Completion, recognizing them as a Persian teacher.

How to apply

If you are interested to apply for our courses; to improve your Persian skills in a natural environment; to get familiar with the Persian literature, culture, and history; to attend Persian for specific purposes courses; to attend our seasonal schools; and to visit Iran and Isfahan, you are kindly requested to do the following steps:

1. Follow the link, <http://old.saorg.ir:8081/application.php>, to the online registration system of the Ministry of Science, Research and Technology (MSRT), and complete the related form.

Note 1: The forms will require you to insert the code of the center you are applying for. **Our code is “305”.**

Note 2: Your CV is one the required documents. **You need to upload your CV in the place where the system asks you to upload your academic degree.**

- After you complete your registration, the system gives you a reference code. Do not forget to send us the code in your email.

2. Fill in the visa application form ([from here](#)) and send it (in a word format) along with the following documents to our visa desk at: ictp@dean.ui.ac.ir

- The color scan of the front page of your passport
- Your color personal photo. The photo must be recent, in a JPEG format and less than 500 KB and

more than 10 KB (Females are kindly asked to take their photos with hijab)

- Your CV

Note: It is important to mention that, you need to follow all aforementioned steps only if you want to participate in face-to-face instructions and study in Isfahan. For our online course, you need to simply contact us at:

Notes:

- The visa application form has some fields that ask for information such as your acceptance type. Please leave them blank if they are not applicable to you.

- Visa application process usually takes up about two months. To avoid any delays, you'd better send us the required documents at least two months before your arrival.

- A reference number will be assigned to you upon the completion of the visa application process. We will send you the number as soon as we receive it. You should have that number to get your visa from the Iranian embassy in your country.

- Please inform us about the exact date of your arrival and your selected accommodation type for the reservation and arrangement purposes.

saorg.ir Registration Tutorial

To register at www.saorg.ir, you need to fill out 5 forms in total.

In the first form, you need to fill out your personal information and your passport information.

In the second form, you need to provide your academic information such as your degree and the field you want to study in Iran. This form will also require you to insert the code of our center (305).

You need to select “[Persian language learner](#)” as

[your level of study](#) and [Persian language \(code: 1080\)](#) as your chosen field. You need to **upload your CV instead of your academic degree**. Your personal CV is one the required documents without which visa processing will not start.

In the third step, you need to introduce two members of your family (preferably your parents) and fill out only their introductory information. Next, you need to state your contact details including: your residence address, telephone number, and email address.

Finally, you need to request for a visa, while different types of visas are included in the list. It is important to mention that you need to select “Educational visa”.

In the last page, you ought to upload your personal photo (Females are kindly asked to take their photos with hijab), passport, academic certificate, and CV images. It is very important to mention that, the images that you aim to upload, should meet technical requirements of the website. First of all, you can only upload files with jpg format. If they do not meet the website's requirements (standard height, width, resolution, and quality are exactly specified), you need to resize them. To do so, you can use many free online image resize software like:

(www.img2go.com/resize-image).

Once you uploaded your files successfully and proceeded to the next page, a “reference code” will be issued for you. Please note that you need to keep a record of your reference code for future steps of your application.
